

## Service Unit Adult Recognition Nomination

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Submit nominations to your service unit manager by a date determined by your service unit. Service units will submit the online form #505 by April 1 to order the award(s) for this nomination.

These awards are for service performed between April 1 and March 31. Candidates for these awards have shown outstanding service to girls and/or adults in Girl Scouts, and actively understand and practice the values of inclusive behavior. See girlscoutsosw.org/volunteer-awards for detailed award descriptions and criteria. These recognitions will be presented at local service unit events.

<b>Outstanding Community Supporter:</b> Recognizes outstanding contributions of time and/or services to local Girl Scout groups by an individual or business. This award is presented in the form of a certificate and can be awarded year after year for continued support. <i>Submit one (1) letter of endorsement.</i>
<b>Outdoor Enthusiast:</b> Recognizes a volunteer who promotes and champions outdoor skill progression in Girl Scouts. Can only be earned once. <i>Submit two (2) letters of endorsement.</i>
<b>Owl Award:</b> Recognizes a volunteer who provides learning opportunities for girls and/or adults in Girl Scouts. This volunteer does not have to be a member of the GSOSW Trainer Corps. <i>Submit two (2) letters of endorsement.</i>
<b>Rising Star Award:</b> Recognizes the service of an individual who is new to Girl Scouts, has hit the ground running and has performed outstanding work within their first two years as a volunteer. <i>Submit two (2) letters of endorsement.</i>
<b>Guiding Star Award:</b> Recognizes a volunteer whose performance mentoring troops/groups merits recogni- tion by the service unit. <i>Submit two (2) letters of endorsement</i> .
