# Ellen Rosenblum



Ellen Rosenblum is the first female attorney general of Oregon and is one of nine female attorneys general in the U.S. She was previously a judge on the Multnomah County Circuit Court for 16 years and a judge on the Oregon Court of Appeals for six years.

Rosenblum has spent her career working to advance women and minorities in the legal and judicial professions and has also served in leadership roles for many national and state legal professional organizations.

She initiated the Girl Scouts Beyond Bars program in Oregon, a Girl Scout troop for girls and their incarcerated mothers. She currently serves on its advisory board.

Rosenblum is married to newspaper owner and publisher Richard Meeker and has two children.
