

# CPR and First Aid Training

In order to keep Girl Scouts a safe place for girls, this class is offered to any volunteer interested in increasing their emergency response skills.

## Who should take this training?

This course is required for volunteers as specified by *GSOSW Council Volunteer Policies and Procedures* and *Safety Activity Checkpoints*. The strictest policy in any given situation is to be followed.

## What does the training include?

Child and adult CPR and first aid training is available from GSOSW, as well as other institutions such as the American Red Cross, National Safety Council, EMP America or the American Heart Association. GSUSA does not approve CPR and First Aid training that is only online - there must be an in person component in order for the training to fulfill Girl Scout requirements.

This training is a two year certification course.

## When does the training need to be completed?

It is recommended that this training is taken at the first available opportunity, and must include training in adult and child CPR.
