\$22,054 provided to **1,100** people for book and uniform assistance.

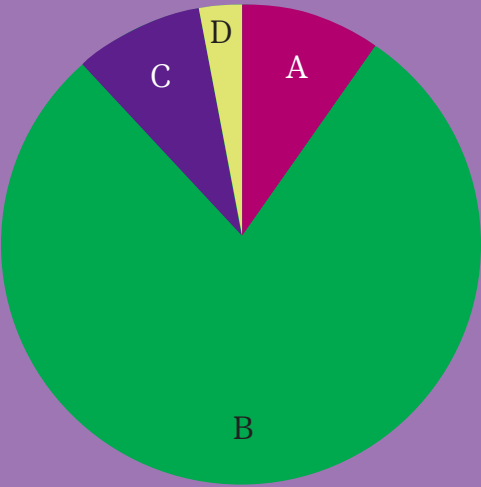

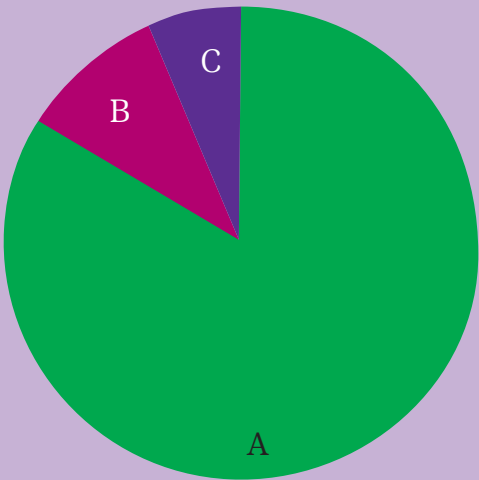
