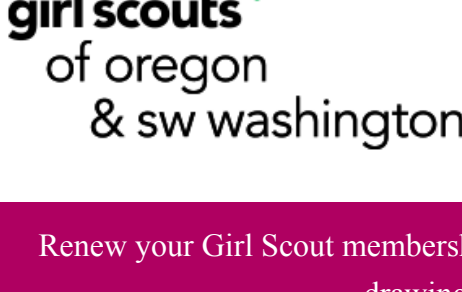

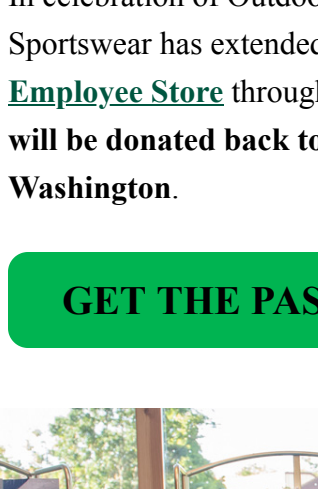


True North Girls' Leadership and Sports Day Camp

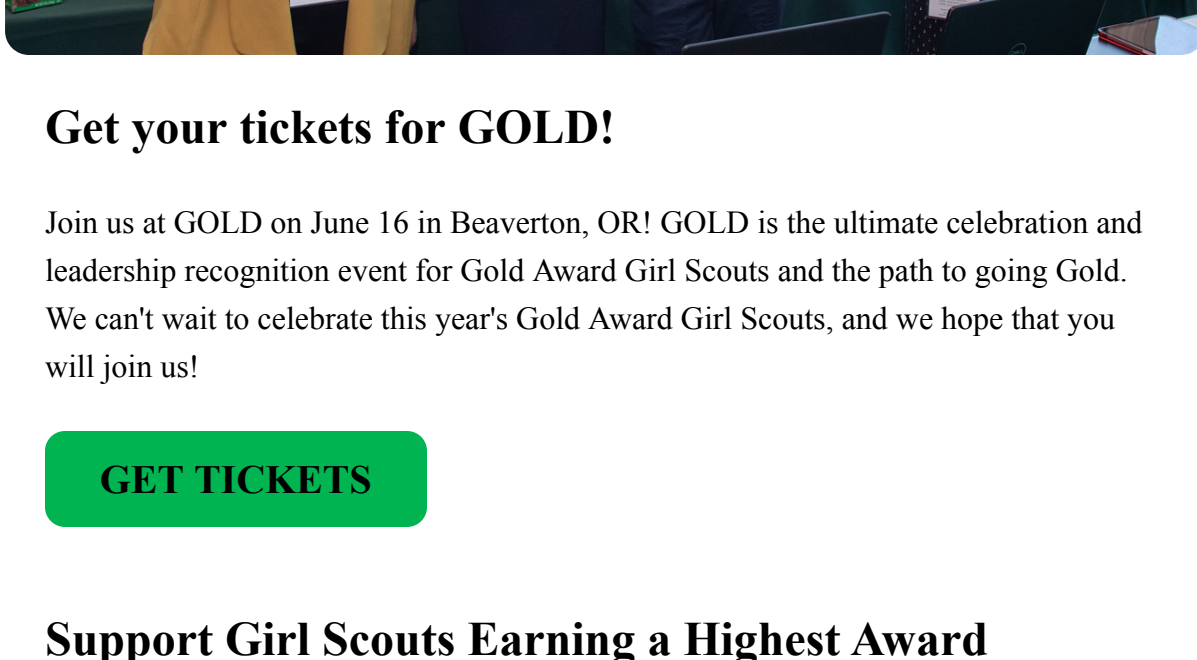

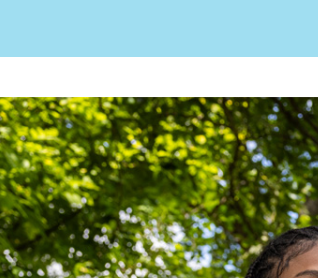

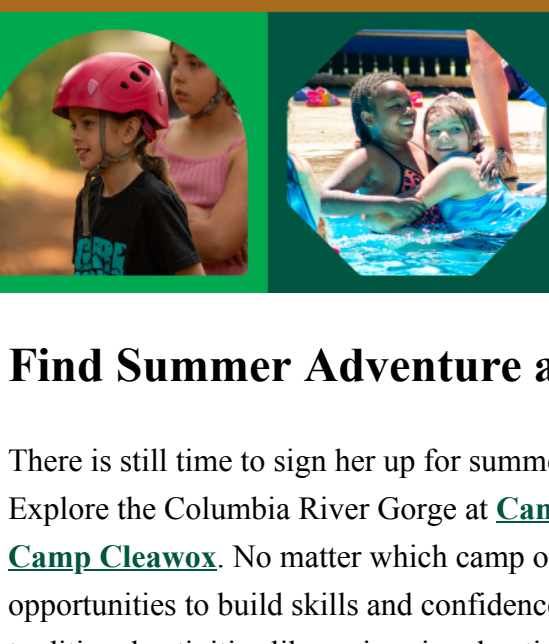
We're talking about things like:

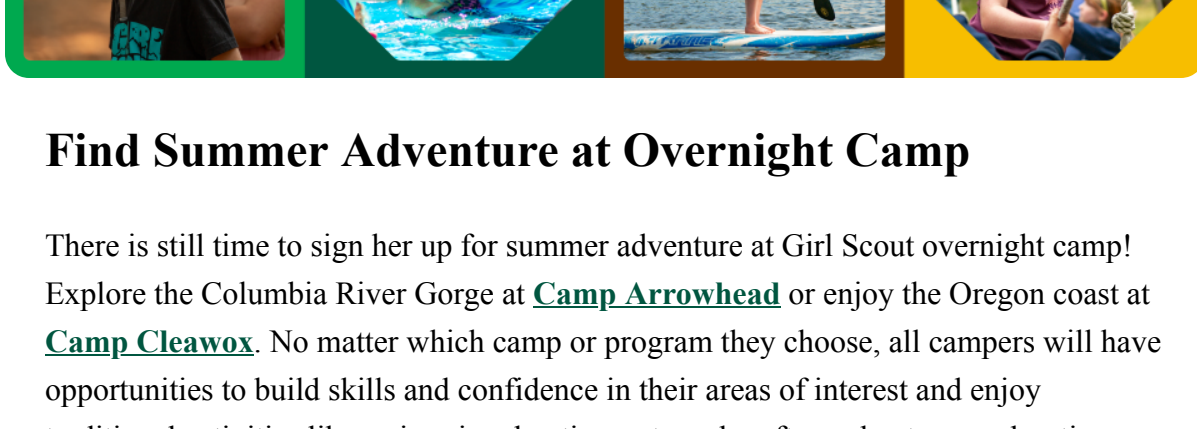
Celebrate Asian American Native Hawaiian Pacific Islander Heritage Month

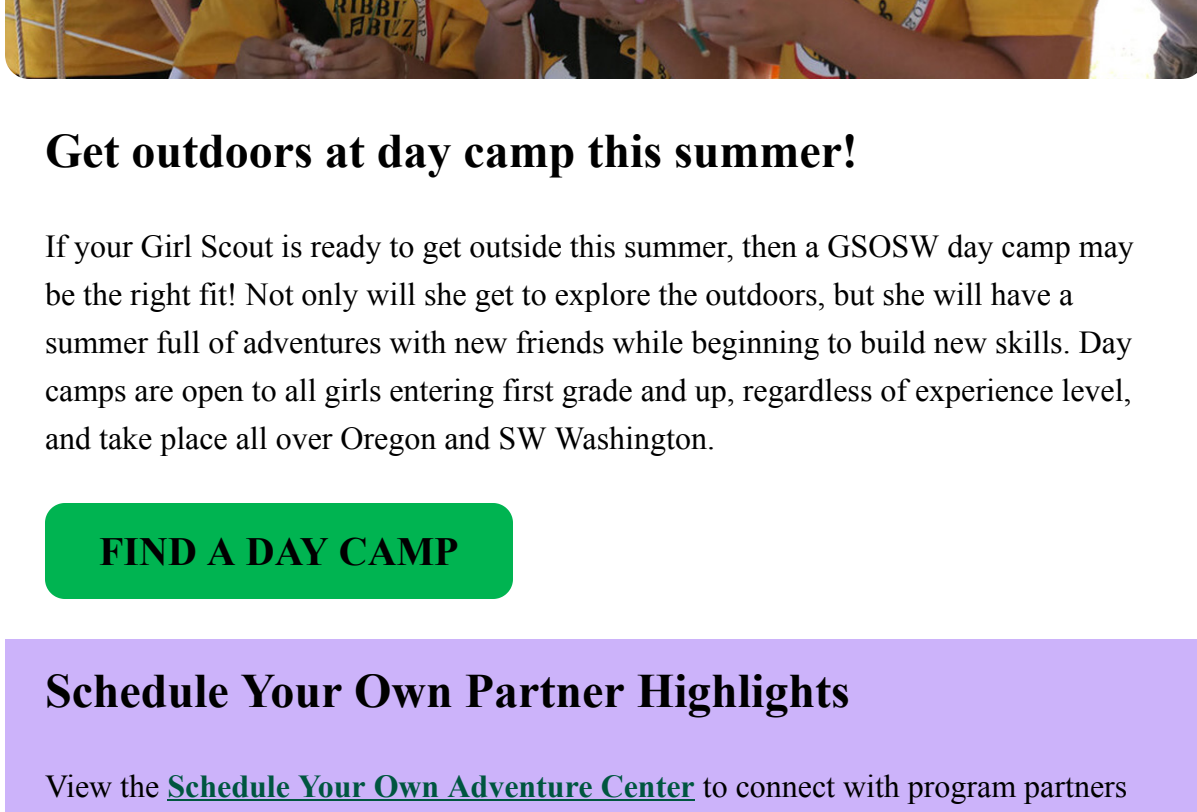

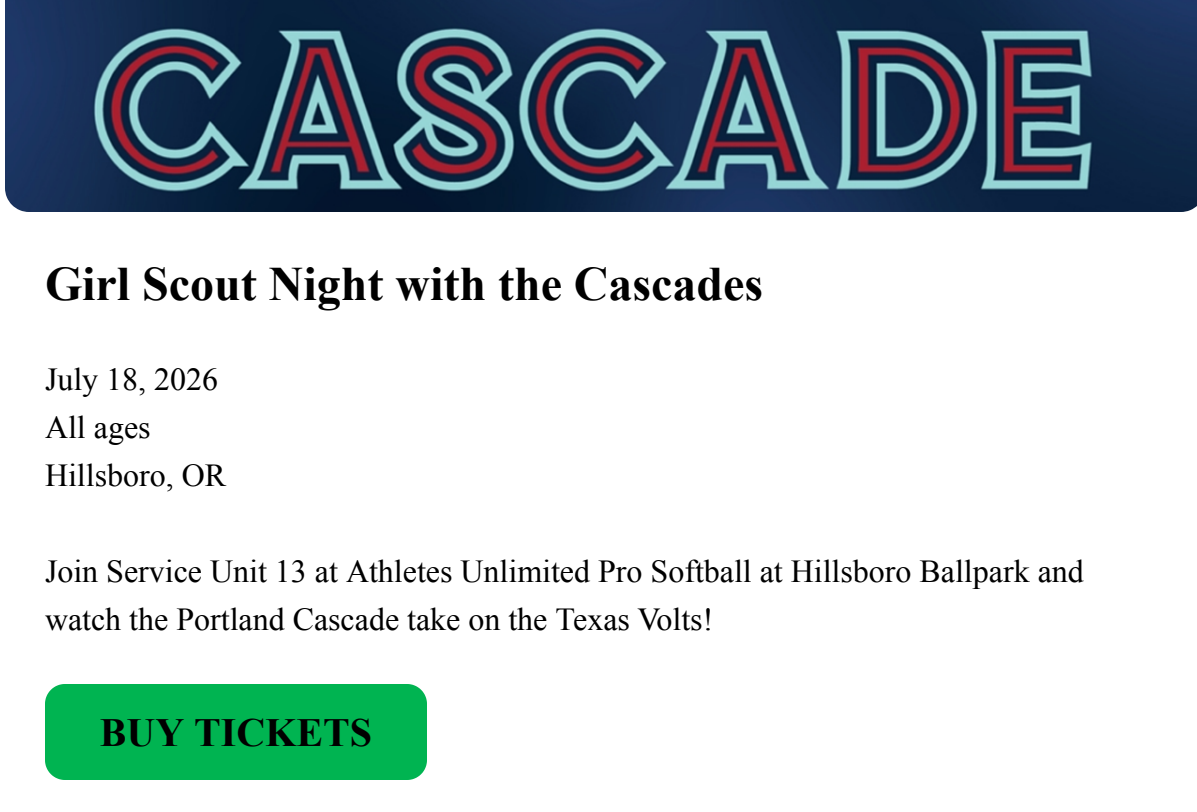


Camp Clean-Up Volunteer Work Parties
