



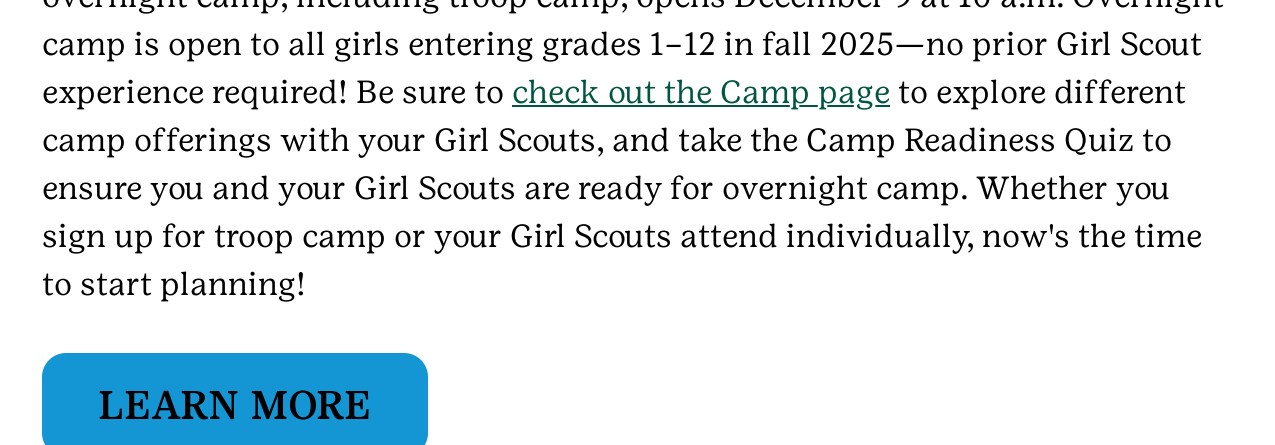

The [Fall Product Program](#) is happening now, Troops and Juliettes: Here's your chance to win one of three \$100 GSOSW Girl Scout Shop gift cards! Here's how:

- Any Girl Scout who makes their first 2025 Fall Product Program sale between November 7–24 earns two entries for the prize drawing.
 - Example: Jane Glow hasn't sold any fall product yet and sells a box of Mint Penguins to her neighbor; Jane's troop will get two entries in the prize drawing.
- For every \$100 your troop sells between November 7–24, your troop (or Juliette) earns one entry into the prize drawing.
 - \$200+ in sales = two entries. \$300+ in sales = three entries, and so on.

All Fall Product Program sales count towards entry, including nuts, candies, magazines, tumblers, candles, BarkBox, and Care to Share. Each Girl Scout can contribute to earning both types of entries. Let's finish the Fall Product Program strong!

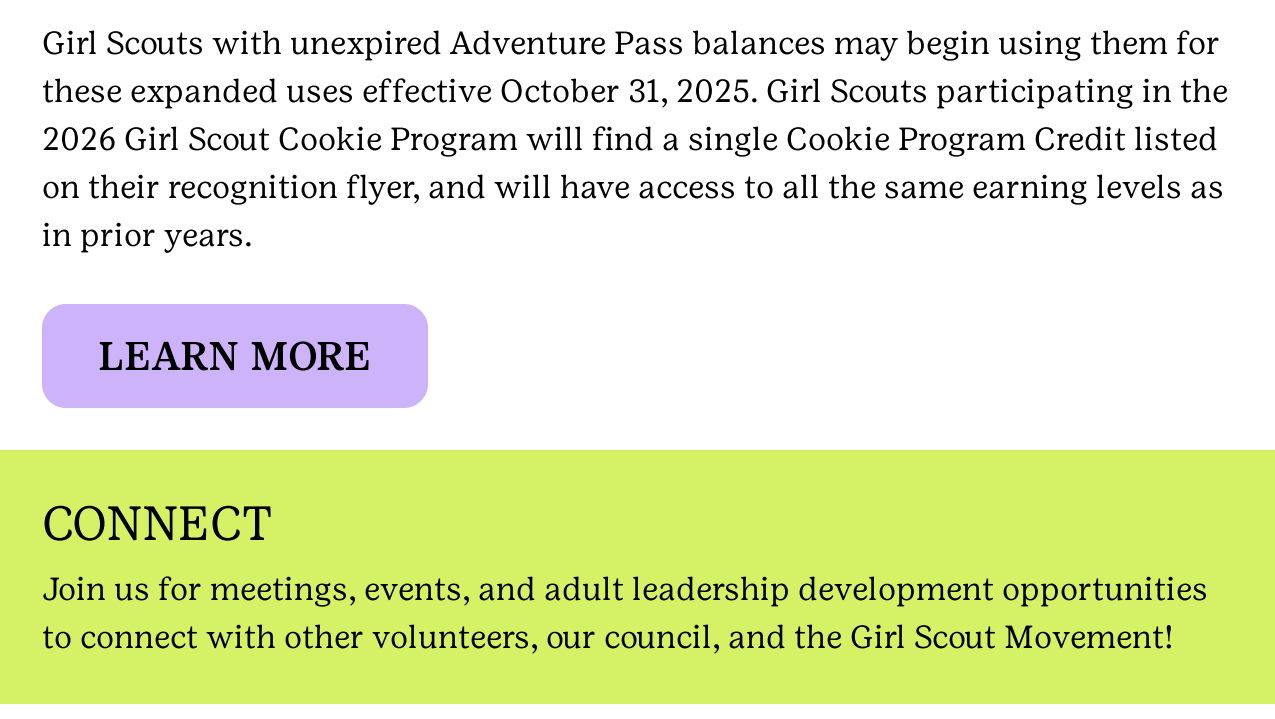

Expanded Uses for Adventure Passes

GSOSW is combining Program Credits and Adventure Passes into a single card beginning this year. All Program Credits can now be used for a wide variety of exciting experiences or GSOSW Girl Scout Shop purchases.

Girl Scouts with unexpired Adventure Pass balances may begin using them for these expanded uses effective October 31, 2025. Girl Scouts participating in the 2026 Girl Scout Cookie Program will find a single Cookie Program Credit listed on their recognition flyer, and will have access to all the same earning levels as in prior years.

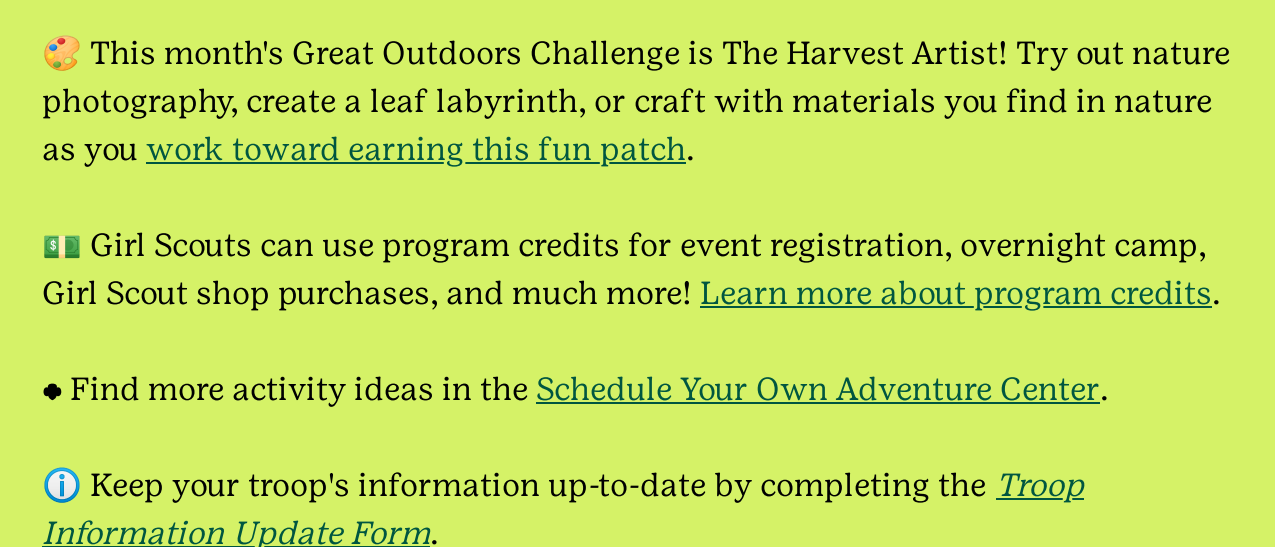

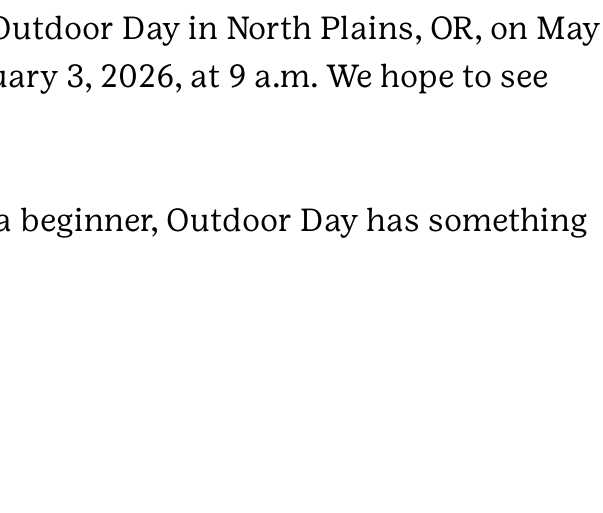
Highest Awards Support Hours

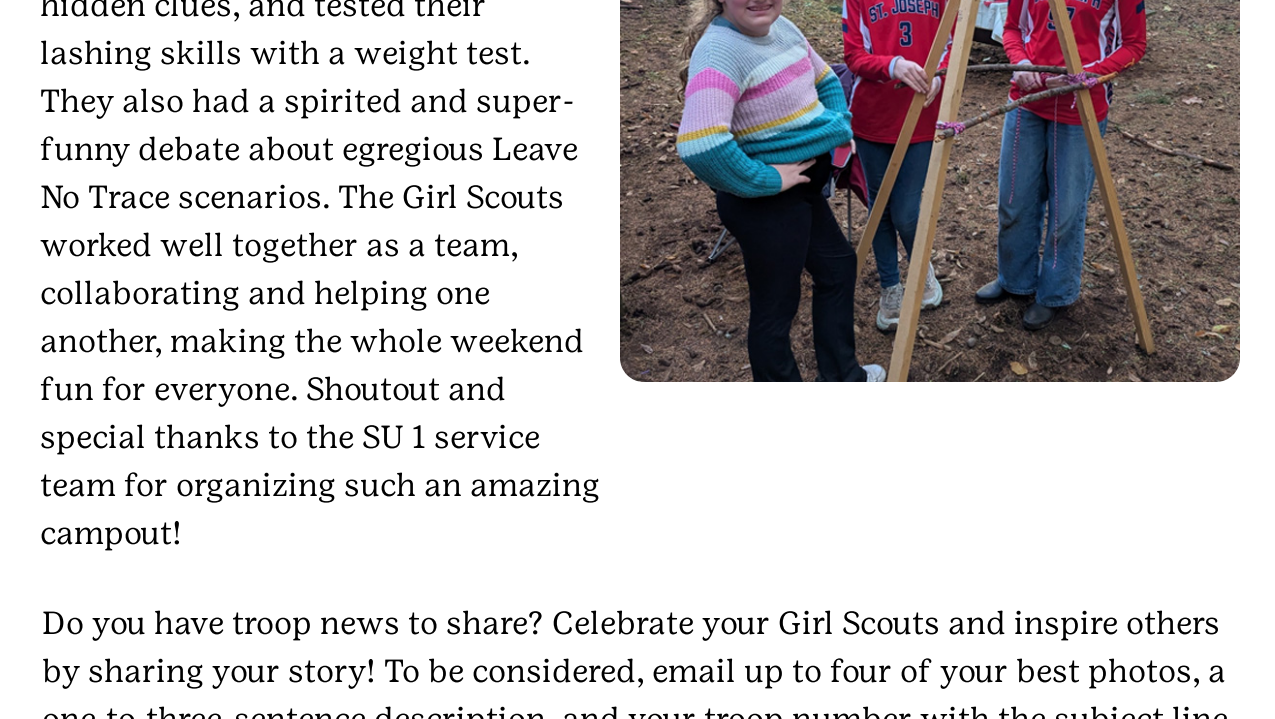
This month's STEAM Challenge is STEM Month! It's the perfect time to start [working toward earning this fun patch](#).
