





## Portland Girl Scout Shop Closures

## The Fall Product Program \$100 Challenge is on!

The [Fall Product Program](#) is happening now. Troops and Juliettes: Here's your chance to win one of three \$100 GSOSW Girl Scout Shop gift cards! Here's how:

- Any Girl Scout who makes their first 2025 Fall Product Program sale between November 7–24 earns two entries for the prize drawing.
  - Example: Jane Glow hasn't sold any fall product yet and sells a box of Mint Penguins to her neighbor; Jane's troop will get two entries in the prize drawing.
- For every \$100 your troop sells between November 7–24, your troop (or Juliette) earns one entry into the prize drawing.
  - \$200+ in sales = two entries. \$300+ in sales = three entries, and so on.

All Fall Product Program sales count towards entry, including nuts, candies, magazines, tumblers, candles, BarkBox, and Care to Share. Each Girl Scout can contribute to earning both types of entries. Let's finish the Fall Product Program strong!


