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As president of Cambia Health Foundation, Peggy works with a wide range of stakeholders to advance equity through whole person health in underserved communities. Peggy is passionate about helping people of all ages, stages and backgrounds achieve optimal well-being, and is dedicated to improving the quality of life for people with serious illness and their caregivers. This requires purposeful philanthropic investments in models that integrate physical, social and behavioral dimensions of health.

Peggy serves on the national board of directors of Grantmakers in Aging and on the Western States Regional Board of the American Heart Association. In 2019, Peggy founded the Oregon Coalition for Living Well with Serious Illness and is a co-convenor of Oregon's Age-Friendly Ecosystem.

Peggy volunteers as a board director or leadership council member of Friends of the Children, Doernbecher Children's Hospital, Start Making a Reader Today (SMART), Habitat for Humanity, the American Heart Association and All Hands Raised. During the pandemic, she served on the Governor's Healthy Schools Reopening Council.

Peggy joined Cambia in 1997 as an associate general counsel and has held several posts, including chief of staff to the CEO, vice president of Legal Services, and director of Litigation & Risk Management. Previously, Peggy worked as an attorney at Garvey Schubert & Barer in Portland.
